Work with professional working methods and ethically impeccable ways. Strive for long-term partnerships.

Use high-level communication methods and techniques.

We expect our suppliers to maintain the confidentiality of our trade secrets, and we do as well in respect to information and data relating to their business.

Our suppliers must comply with laws and regulations regarding the prevention of bribery, corruption and fraud and the prevention of other prohibited business practices. They shall not offer, promise or grant any undue advantage, favor or financial benefit to a public official, international organization or other person. The Supplier may not, directly or indirectly, offer gifts to employees or representatives of the Bonafarm Group or persons directly related to them, up to a token value only.

We strongly against all forms of money laundering and take the necessary measures to prevent our financial transactions from being used by others for money laundering purposes. We also expect our suppliers to comply with this to the maximum.

Under no circumstances may a supplier infringe or participate in such conduct, including, for example, provisions relating to agreements restricting economic competition, price fixing, market sharing and other conducts that is against to the relevant competition rules.
